



Scape and Loughborough University

Loughborough University, in conjunction with the EMCBE and Scape, have initiated a 'Knowledge Transfer Collaboration' (KTC) to investigate how Best Value can be achieved by Local Authorities, particularly by using 'innovative construction methods' (ICM). Lawrence Mckay has been engaged to work on this for a two year period. Lawrence is working with Scape, their clients and suppliers to pick up on their work practices and experiences in delivering Scape projects.



During his work, he will investigate the barriers to ICM and potential areas for using more ICM as well as making recommendations for improvements in the wider project delivery process using Scape Technology. A key outcome will be the development of an Offsite/ICM 'Decision Tool' which will enable Local Authorities to evaluate the true potential of ICM technologies in relation to more traditional methods and make informed decisions early in the design process.
